

The Road Humps Ordinance, 1998

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 29th day of April, 1998¹ and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 1(8)(a) of the Road Traffic (Road Humps) (Guernsey) Law, 1983², as amended³, hereby order -

Dimensions of road humps.

1. Any road hump constructed or maintained in a public highway shall not raise the surface of the public highway by more than 100 millimetres above, or lower the surface of the public highway by more than 40 millimetres below, the surface of the public highway on either side of the hump or depression.

Citation.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Road Humps Ordinance, 1998.

Commencement.

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 29th day of October, 1998.
