Ordinance of the States **XL**

1967

Made 27th September, 1967

Coming into Operation 20th October, 1967

**The Road Traffic (Bus Terminus)
Ordinance, 1967**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the thirty-first day of May, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven, hereby order:—

1. (1) A person being in charge of a vehicle or an animal shall not, without the permission of the Chief Officer, drive or ride that vehicle or permit that animal to proceed on the Albert Pier, Saint Peter Port, otherwise than in such manner that:—

- (a) upon entering the said Pier, the Albert Statue is on his right-hand side;
- (b) upon emerging from the said Pier, he turns to the South along the carriageway to the East of the Bus Terminus, the Albert Statue being on his right-hand side.

(2) A person being in charge of an omnibus shall not, without the permission of the Chief Officer, drive that omnibus:—

- (a) into the Bus Terminus at its northern entrance otherwise than in such manner that the Albert Statue is on his left-hand side;
 - (b) so as to emerge from the Bus Terminus otherwise than from its north-west exit by turning to the North into the South Esplanade, Saint Peter Port.
- (3) A person being in charge of a vehicle or an animal shall not, without the permission of the Chief Officer, drive or ride that vehicle or permit that animal to proceed on or along:—
- (a) the carriageway to the East of the Bus Terminus, otherwise than from North to South;
 - (b) that portion of the South Esplanade, Saint Peter Port, between Norman House and its junction with Church Hill, otherwise than from South to North.
- (4) A person being in charge of a vehicle or an animal and driving or riding that vehicle or permitting that animal to proceed from North to South along the Quay, Saint Peter Port, shall not, without the permission of the Chief Officer, turn that vehicle or permit that animal to turn to the right between a point opposite to Quay Street and the Albert Statue save that nothing in this section shall be taken to prevent a person being in charge of an omnibus turning that omnibus to the right for the purpose of entering the Bus Terminus.
- (5) A person being in charge of a vehicle or an animal shall not, without the permission of the Chief Officer, drive or ride that vehicle or permit that animal to proceed around the roundabout, or any part thereof, at the southern end of the Bus Terminus, otherwise than in a clockwise direction.

2. A person who contravenes the provisions of section one of this Ordinance shall be guilty of an offence and liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding ten pounds. Penalty.

3. Paragraph 15 of the Second Schedule to the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1956 (a) is hereby repealed. Repeal.

4. In this Ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, that is to say:— Interpretation.

“animal” does not include a dog or a cat;

“the Bus Terminus” means the Bus Terminus situate at the South Esplanade, Saint Peter Port;

“the Chief Officer” means the Chief Officer of the Island Police Force;

“omnibus” means a mechanically propelled vehicle which is ordinarily used for the purposes of a public omnibus service in accordance with the provisions of a road service licence issued by the Passenger Transport Licensing Authority in pursuance of the provisions of the Public Transport Licensing Ordinance, 1966 (b);

“vehicle” means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on a public highway and includes an animal drawn vehicle, a bicycle and a tricycle.

(2) Except where the context otherwise requires, any reference in this Ordinance to any other enactment shall be construed as including a reference

to that enactment as amended, repealed and replaced, extended or applied by or under any other enactment.

5. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Road Traffic (Bus Terminus) Ordinance, 1967.

(2) This Ordinance shall come into force on the twentieth day of October, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven.
