The Road Traffic (Bus Terminus) Ordinance, 1967

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the thirty-first day of May, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven, hereby order: –

Regulation of traffic at Bus Terminus.

1. (1) ...

(2) ...

(3) ...

(4) A person being in charge of a vehicle or an animal and driving or riding that vehicle or permitting that animal to proceed from North to South along the Quay, Saint Peter Port, shall not, without the permission of the Chief Officer, turn that vehicle or permit that animal to turn to the right between a point opposite to Quay Street and the Albert Statue [...].

(5) A person being in charge of a vehicle or an animal shall not, without the permission of the Chief Officer, drive or ride that vehicle or permit that animal to proceed around the roundabout, or any part thereof, at the southern end of the Bus Terminus, otherwise than in a clockwise direction.

NOTES

In section 1,

subsection (1), subsection (2) and subsection (3) were repealed by the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Ordinance, 1985, section

the words omitted in square brackets in subsection (4) were repealed by the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Ordinance, 1985, section 2, Schedule, with effect from 1st July, 1985.

Penalty.

2. A person who contravenes the provisions of section one of this Ordinance shall be guilty of an offence and liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding [level 1 on the uniform scale].

NOTE

In section 2, the words and figure in square brackets were substituted by the Uniform Scale of Fines (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1989, section 2(2), with effect from 1st July, 1989.

Repeal.

Section 3 was repealed by the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1970, section 7, Fifth Schedule, with effect from 1st February, 1970.

Interpretation.

4. In this Ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, that is to say –

"animal" does not include a dog or a cat,

"the Bus Terminus" means the Bus Terminus situate at the South Esplanade, Saint Peter Port;

"the Chief Officer" means the Chief Officer of the Island Police Force;

"vehicle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on a public highway and includes an animal drawn vehicle, a bicycle and a tricycle.

(2) Except where the context otherwise requires, any reference in this Ordinance to any other enactment shall be construed as including a reference to that enactment as amended, repealed and replaced, extended or applied by or under any other enactment.

NOTE

In section 4, the words omitted in square brackets were repealed by the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Ordinance, 1985, section 2, Schedule, with effect from 1st July, 1985.

Citation and commencement.

5. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Road Traffic (Bus Terminus) Ordinance, 1967.

(2) This Ordinance shall come into force on the twentieth day of October, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven.
