IN THE ROYAL COURT OF THE ISLAND OF GUERNSEY

The 31st day of January, 1959, before Sir Ambrose James Sherwill, C.B.E., M.C., Bailiff; present:— Sir John Leale, William Robert Freake Clark, Esquire, Bertram Bartlett, Esquire, O.B.E., Donald Carey Brock, Esquire, C.B.E., Osmond Priaulx, Esquire, Wilfred John Corbet, Esquire, O.B.E., Théophile Le Messurier Allez, Bertram Guy Blampied, Esquires, Richard Edward Gibson, Esquire, O.B.E., Claude Fortescue Nason, Henry Robin Bichard and Stanley Walter Gavey, Esquires, Jurats.

The Bailiff having this day placed before the Court an Order of Her Majesty in Council dated the 19th day of December, 1958, ratifying a *Projet de Loi* entitled "The Road Traffic (Compulsory Third Party Insurance) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1958",— the Court, after the reading of the said Order in Council and after having heard Her Majesty's Procureur thereon, ordered that the said Order in Council be registered on the records of this Island, of which Order in Council the tenor followeth:—

WHEREAS there was this day read at the Board a Report from the Right Honourable the Lords of the Committee of Council for the Affairs of Guernsey and Jersey, dated the 1st day of December, 1958, in the words following, viz.:—

“YOUR MAJESTY having been pleased, by Your General Order of Reference of the 22nd day of February, 1952, to refer unto this Committee the humble Petition of the States of the Island of Guernsey, setting forth:—

1. That, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 11th day of December, 1957, the States of Deliberation at a meeting held on the 5th day of November, 1958, approved a Bill or “Projet de Loi” entitled “The Road Traffic (Compulsory Third Party Insurance) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1958” and requested the Bailiff to present a most humble Petition to Your Majesty in Council praying for Your Royal Sanction thereto.
2. That the said Bill or “Projet de Loi” is in the words and figures set forth in the Schedule hereunto annexed. And most humbly praying that Your Majesty might be graciously pleased

to grant Your Royal Sanction to the Bill or "Projet de Loi" of the States of Guernsey entitled "The Road Traffic (Compulsory Third Party Insurance) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1958" and to order that the same shall have the force of Law in the Island of Guernsey.'


"THE LORDS OF THE COMMITTEE, in obedience to Your Majesty's said Order of Reference, have taken the said Petition and the said Projet de Loi into consideration, and do this day agree humbly to report, as their opinion, to Your Majesty, that it may be advisable for Your Majesty to comply with the prayer of the said Petition and to approve of and ratify the said Projet de Loi."

HER MAJESTY having taken the said Report into consideration is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to approve of and ratify the said Projet de Loi, and to order, as it is hereby ordered, that the same shall have the force of Law within the Island of Guernsey.

AND HER MAJESTY doth hereby further direct that this Order, and the said Projet de Loi (a copy whereof is hereunto annexed) be entered upon the Register of the Island of Guernsey and observed accordingly.

AND the Lieutenant Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Island of Guernsey, the Bailiff and Jurats, and all other Her Majesty's Officers, for the time being, in the said Island, and all other persons whom it may concern, are to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.

PROJET DE LOI

ENTITLED

The Road Traffic (Compulsory Third Party Insurance) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1958

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the eleventh day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven, have approved the following provisions which, subject to the Sanction of Her Most Excellent Majesty in Council, shall have force of law in this Island.

1. The Road Traffic (Compulsory Third Party Insurance) (Guernsey) Law, 1936, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law") is hereby further amended as follows:—

- (a) section one thereof is re-numbered as subsection (1) of section one and the following additional subsection is inserted immediately thereafter—

"(2) References in this Law to any other enactment shall, except where the context otherwise requires, be construed as references to that enactment as amended, repealed, replaced, extended or applied by or under any other enactment, including this Law.";

- (b) in subsection (2) of section two thereof the word "summary" is hereby deleted;
- (c) in subsection (2) of section two thereof the word "Magistrate" where that word occurs is hereby deleted and the word "court" is hereby substituted therefor;
- (d) in subsection (1) of section fifteen thereof all the words beginning with the words "he shall" to the end of that subsection are hereby deleted and the following words substituted therefor—
"he shall be guilty of an offence and liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding two hundred pounds or to a term of imprisonment, with or without hard labour, not exceeding two years, or to both such fine and imprisonment.";
- (e) in subsections (2) and (3) of section fifteen thereof the words "upon summary conviction before the Royal Court" are hereby deleted and the words "on conviction" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (f) subsection (1) of section sixteen thereof is hereby repealed.

2. This Law and the principal Law may be cited together as the Road Traffic (Compulsory Third Party Insurance) (Guernsey) Laws, 1936 and 1958.
