The Road Traffic (Construction and Use of Motor Vehicles) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1980

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the thirtieth day of January, nineteen hundred and eighty, hereby order:—

1. The Road Traffic (Construction and Use of Motor Vehicles) Ordinance, 1970, as amended^(a), is hereby further amended as follows:—

(a) section two thereof is renumbered as subsection (1) of section two and immediately thereafter there is inserted the following additional subsection numbered “(2)”—

“(2) The provisions of section one of this Ordinance shall not apply in the case of a public service vehicle in respect of which there is for the time being in force either

a private hire omnibus licence or a public service omnibus licence and of which the overall width is not in excess of seven feet six inches when it is used on any public highway—

(a) for the purposes either of a public omnibus service or a public excursion service; or

(b) as a private hire omnibus;

on a route approved for the purposes of this subsection by the Passenger Transport Licensing Authority constituted under the provisions of the Public Transport Licensing (Guernsey) Law, 1964.”;

(b) in subsection (1) of section nine thereof—

(i) immediately after the definition of the expression “overall width” there are inserted the following additional definitions—

“private hire omnibus” has the meaning assigned to it by section fifty of the Public Transport Licensing Ordinance, 1966;

“private hire omnibus licence” has the meaning assigned to it by section fifty of the Public Transport Licensing Ordinance, 1966;

“public excursion service” has the meaning assigned to it by section fifty of the Public Transport Licensing Ordinance, 1966;”;

(ii) immediately after the definition of the expression “public highway” there are inserted the following additional definitions—

““public omnibus service” has the meaning assigned to it by section fifty of the Public Transport Licensing Ordinance, 1966;

“public service omnibus licence” has the meaning assigned to it by section fifty of the Public Transport Licensing Ordinance, 1966;”.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Road Traffic Citation. (Construction and Use of Motor Vehicles) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1980.

3. This Ordinance and the Road Traffic (Construction and Use of Motor Vehicles) Ordinances, 1970 to 1976, may be cited together as the Road Traffic (Construction and Use of Motor Vehicles) Ordinances, 1970 to 1980. **Collective title.**
