The Road Traffic (Construction and Use of Motor Vehicles) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1984

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 28th day of March, 1984, hereby order:—

1. In section 2(2) of the Road Traffic (Construction and Use of Motor Vehicles) Ordinance, 1970, as amended^(a), the full stop at the end thereof is deleted and a colon is substituted therefor and immediately thereafter there is hereby inserted the following proviso—

“Provided that for the purposes of this subsection a public service vehicle which is described by its manufacturers as not exceeding an overall width of seven feet six inches shall be treated as complying with the provisions of this subsection if by

reason of inaccuracies in manufacture or settlement of its body or chassis the overall width of the vehicle does not exceed seven feet six inches by more than three quarters of an inch.”.

Citation. 2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Road Traffic (Construction and Use of Motor Vehicles) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1984.

Collective title. 3. This Ordinance and the Road Traffic (Construction and Use of Motor Vehicles) Ordinances, 1970 to 1982, may be cited together as the Road Traffic (Construction and Use of Motor Vehicles) Ordinances, 1970 to 1984.
