**The Road Traffic (Driving School Signs)
Ordinance, 1990**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 28th day of June, 1990(a), hereby order:—

1. (1) The functions of the Chief Officer of Police arising under or by virtue of section 5(1)(c) of the Motor Vehicles (Miscellaneous Provisions) Ordinance, 1962(b) (“the Ordinance”) are transferred to and vested in the Committee. Transfer of functions.

(2) In this Ordinance “the Committee” means the Island Traffic Committee, or such other Committee or like body of the States as the States may from time to time prescribe by Resolution under this section.

2. Nothing done by or in relation to the Chief Officer of Police under or by virtue of section 5(1)(c) of the Ordinance before the commencement of this Ordinance shall be invalidated by such commencement. Savings.

- Amendment. 3. In section 5(1) of the Ordinance delete the words “the Chief Officer of Police” and substitute “the Island Traffic Committee”.
- Citation. 4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Road Traffic (Driving School Signs) Ordinance, 1990.
- Commence-
ment. 5. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 1st October, 1990.
