**The Road Traffic (Fountain Street)
(Clearway) Ordinance, 1970**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-eighth day of January, nineteen hundred and seventy, hereby order:—

1. (1) A person being in charge of an animal or a vehicle, other than a motor delivery vehicle, shall not, without the permission in writing of the Chief

Officer, cause or permit that animal or vehicle to wait on any part of the carriageway of Fountain Street, Saint Peter Port, otherwise than to permit pedestrians to cross at the pedestrian crossing, on any weekday between the hours of eight o'clock in the forenoon and six o'clock in the afternoon.

(2) A person being in charge of a motor delivery vehicle shall not, without the permission in writing of the Chief Officer, cause or permit that vehicle to wait on any part of the carriageway of Fountain Street, Saint Peter Port, otherwise than to permit pedestrians to cross at the pedestrian crossing or to load or unload at a loading bay, on any weekday between the hours of ten o'clock in the forenoon and six o'clock in the afternoon.

2. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of an offence and liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding ten pounds. Penalty.

3. In this Ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, that is to say:— Interpretation.

“animal” does not include a dog or a cat;

“Chief Officer” means the Chief Officer of the Island Police Force;

“motor delivery vehicle” means any vehicle which is designed or constructed for use wholly or mainly for the carriage of goods;

“vehicle” means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on a public highway and includes an animal drawn vehicle, a bicycle and a tricycle.

4. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Road Traffic (Fountain Street) (Clearway) Ordinance, 1970. Citation and commencement.

(2) This Ordinance shall come into force on the eighth day of March, nineteen hundred and seventy.
