Made 27th July, 1988.
Coming into Operation ... 1st August, 1988.

The Road Traffic Offences (Increase in Fines) Ordinance, 1988

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 25th day of May, 1988, hereby order:—

1. In Article XII(4) of the Ordinance entitled “Ordonnance relative au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile” of 2nd March 1929(a), for “fifty pounds” there is substituted “£200”. Failure to stop after, or report, certain accidents.

2. In section 2 of the Ordinance entitled “Ordonnance Supplémentaire à l’Ordonnance ayant rapport au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile du 2 mars 1929” of 14th December 1929(b), for “£5” there is substituted “£100”. Carrying passengers on bicycles.

3. (1) For section 8 of the Road Traffic (Construction and Use of Motor Vehicles) Ordinance, 1970(c), there is substituted: Construction and use offences.

“ 8. (1) A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Ordinance is guilty of an offence and liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding £200.

(2) A person who—

(a) fails to comply with any condition attached to a permission granted under section 5 of this Ordinance; or

(b) wilfully obstructs any person in the exercise of his powers under the provisions of section 7 of this Ordinance; or

(c) for the purpose of obtaining permission in pursuance of the provisions of section 1 or section 3 of this Ordinance or in furnishing any information which he is required to furnish, makes any statement which he knows to be false in a material particular or recklessly makes any statement which is false in a material particular or furnishes or allows to be furnished any document or information which he knows to be false in a material particular,

is guilty of an offence and liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding £100.”.

(2) Section 8(c) of the Road Traffic (Construction and Use of Motor Vehicles) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1971^(d) is repealed.

Traffic Offences (Increase in Fines) Ordinance, 1988.
