**The Road Traffic (Lower Vauvert)
(Clearway) Ordinance, 1984**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 25th day of April, 1984, hereby order:—

1. A person being in charge of a vehicle or an animal shall not, without the permission of the Chief Officer, cause or permit that vehicle or animal to wait on any part of the carriageway of Lower Vauvert, Saint Peter Port, otherwise than to permit pedestrians to cross at the pedestrian crossings, on any day other than a Saturday, a Sunday or a Bank Holiday, between the hours of—

Restriction
on waiting
in Lower

- (a) half past eight and nine o'clock in the forenoon;
- (b) twelve noon and quarter to one in the afternoon;
- (c) quarter past three and four o'clock in the afternoon;

(d) five o'clock and half past five in the afternoon.

Offence.

2. Any person who contravenes a provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of an offence and, subject to section 3 of this Ordinance, shall be liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding £10.

Fixed
Penalty.

3. (1) The Traffic Offences (Fixed Penalties) Ordinance, 1975, as amended^(a) (hereafter in this section referred to as "the 1975 Ordinance") is further amended in accordance with subsection (2) of this section; and an offence under section 2 of this Ordinance is accordingly a scheduled offence for the purposes of the 1975 Ordinance.

(2) In the First Schedule to the 1975 Ordinance there is inserted, immediately after item 9, the following item:

‘ 10.	Offences punishable under section 2 of the Road Traffic (Lower Vauvert) (Clearway) Ordinance, 1984 £3.50”.

Interpreta-
tion.

4. In this Ordinance—

“animal” does not include a dog or a cat;

“Chief Officer” means the Chief Officer of the
Island Police Force;

“vehicle” includes a mechanically propelled vehicle, a cycle, an animal drawn vehicle and a hand drawn vehicle.

5. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Road Traffic (Lower Vauvert) (Clearway) Ordinance, 1984. Citation and Commencement.

(2) This Ordinance shall come into force on the 18th day of June, 1984.
