**The Road Traffic (Market Street and  
Market Square Parking) Ordinance, 1960**

THE STATES, on the representations of the Island Police Committee, hereby order:—

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Regulations Governing Parking Places and the Schedule thereto, as amended, which said Regulations were by Ordinance of the Royal Court, passed on the twenty-eighth day of March, nineteen hundred and thirty-six, a person being in charge of a vehicle shall not, without the permission in writing of the Chief Officer of Police, allow that vehicle to remain on the South side of Market Street or of Market Square, in the parish of Saint Peter Port, during the hours in which the Public Markets are open for business save that a person being in charge of a motor delivery

vehicle may allow that vehicle to remain on that side of that Street or that Square for any continuous period not exceeding a period of one hundred and twenty minutes during the said hours.

2. For the purposes of this Ordinance the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:—

“motor delivery vehicle” means any vehicle which is designed or constructed for use wholly or mainly for the carriage of goods;

“vehicle” has the meaning assigned to it by Article 1 of the Ordinance entitled “Ordonnance ayant rapport au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile” of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, as amended.

3. Any person who contravenes the provisions of section one of this Ordinance shall be guilty of an offence and liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding five pounds and, on the second and any subsequent conviction, to a fine not exceeding ten pounds.

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the twenty-sixth day of October, nineteen hundred and sixty.
