The [Road Traffic] (Parking Places) Ordinance, 1963

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-seventh day of February, nineteen hundred and sixty-three, and on the representations of the Island Police Committee, hereby order: –

Powers of Committee as respects parking places.

1. (1) The [States [Committee for the Environment & Infrastructure] or such other Committee as the States may by Resolution prescribe] (hereinafter referred to as "**the Committee**") may, from time to time, by order –

- (a) designate such areas or parts of public highways (hereinafter referred to as "**disc parking places**") as it considers necessary or desirable for use for the parking of vehicles using a parking disc in accordance with the provisions of section three of this Ordinance,
- (b) designate such areas or parts of public highways (hereinafter referred to as "**approved parking places**") as it considers necessary or desirable for use for the parking of vehicles or motor bicycles,
- (c) prescribe the conditions subject to which a person, being in charge of a vehicle or a motor bicycle, may park that vehicle or motor bicycle in a disc parking place or an approved parking place,
- (d) prescribe the period during which a person, being in charge of a vehicle or a motor bicycle, may park that

vehicle or motor bicycle in a disc parking place or an approved parking place,

- (e) prescribe the class of vehicle or motor bicycle which may be parked in a disc parking place or an approved parking place[,
- (f) prescribe the period during which a person, being in charge of a vehicle or a motor bicycle, shall not park that vehicle or motor bicycle in a disc parking place or an approved parking place].

(2) An order made under the provisions of the last preceding subsection may make different provisions for different disc parking places and for different approved parking places and for different classes of vehicles and may make different provisions for different categories of vehicles within those classes.

[(3) In any case where the Committee proposes to make an order under this section, the Committee shall publish in "La Gazette Officielle" a notice of the Committee's proposal, stating the terms of the draft order, the address to which objections to the proposal may be sent and the period, which shall be not less than seven days beginning with the date on which the notice is published in accordance with this subsection, within which any such objection may be so sent.

(4) The Committee shall before making an order under this section consider any objection sent to the Committee in accordance with a notice under subsection (3) of this section.]

Persons may park in parking places.

2. Subject to the provision of any order made under the provisions of the last preceding section, a person, being in charge of a vehicle or a motor bicycle –

- (a) may, subject to the provisions of the next succeeding section, park that vehicle in a disc parking place, and
- (b) may park that vehicle or motor bicycle in an approved parking place.

Persons must use discs in certain parking places.

3. A person who, being in charge of a vehicle, parks that vehicle in a disc parking place on any weekday shall, as soon as may be after arriving thereat, set the clock [...] of a parking disc to indicate the time at which the vehicle arrived at the disc

parking place and shall fix the parking disc against the internal face of the windscreen of the vehicle or, if the vehicle has no windscreen, at a convenient place, on the left or near side of the vehicle, in such manner that [the face of the clock indicating the time of arrival as aforesaid] on the parking disc may be distinctly seen by a person outside or alongside the vehicle.

Time during which parking permitted.

4. (1) A person, being in charge of a vehicle, shall not allow that vehicle to remain parked in a disc parking place or an approved parking place for any continuous period reckoned from the time at which the vehicle arrived thereat, greater than that prescribed as respects that disc parking place or approved parking place, as the case may be, by an order made under the provisions of section one of this Ordinance and such person shall, at the expiration of such period, remove that vehicle from within the limits of that disc parking place or approved parking place.

(2) For the purposes of the last preceding subsection as respects disc parking places, the time indicated by the clock [...] of a parking disc fixed to a vehicle parked in a disc parking place shall, until the contrary be proved, be presumed to be the time at which the vehicle last arrived thereat.

[Prohibition against re-parking in specified parking place, within the prescribed period and time.

4A. (1) An order made under the provisions of section 1 of this Ordinance may include a provision prohibiting the re-parking of any vehicle within the period and time as shall be prescribed in the order in any disc parking place or approved parking place as shall for the purposes of this section be prescribed in the order; and different periods and times may be prescribed in respect of different disc parking places and approved parking places.

(2) Where a person, being in charge of a vehicle, has removed that vehicle in compliance with the requirements of section 4 of this Ordinance from any disc parking place or approved parking place to which the provisions of this section applies, he shall not re-park that vehicle or cause or permit any other person to re-park that vehicle within any part of that disc parking place or approved parking place, as the case may be, within the period and time prescribed in respect thereof beginning with the time of such aforesaid removal.]

Parking Places Order, 1991.

[Trade and business prohibited.

4B. A person, being in charge of a vehicle or motor bicycle shall not park that vehicle or motor bicycle in any disc parking place or approved parking place and

engage, or cause or permit any other person to engage, in any trade or business in or from that vehicle or motor bicycle, as the case may be, while so parked.]

Parking Signs.

5. The Committee may, from time to time, erect, maintain and alter on or near any public highway signs [(hereinafter referred to as "**parking signs**")] [in the form of the signs numbered 57 and 58 in Schedule 2 to the Traffic Signs and Traffic Light Signals Ordinance, 1988] indicating –

- (i) the limits of any disc parking place or approved parking place,
- (ii) the conditions upon and the manner in which any disc parking place or approved parking place shall be used.

Notices as to orders made.

6. The Committee shall, as soon as may be after the making of an order under the provisions of section one of this Ordinance, cause a notice to be published in "La Gazette Officielle" setting out the contents of the order.

[Parking in parking places with permission.

6A. (1) An order made under the provisions of section 1 of this Ordinance may include a provision empowering the Committee or the Chief Officer of Police, as shall be specified in the order, to give permission in writing authorising a person, being in charge of a vehicle or motor bicycle, to park that vehicle or motor bicycle in any disc parking place or approved parking place as shall be specified in the aforesaid permission without compliance with the provisions of the order regulating the parking of vehicles or motor bicycles in any such disc parking place or approved parking place. as the case may be.

(2) For the purposes of this section any power conferred on the Committee to give a permission in any order made under the provisions of section 1 of this Ordinance shall include a like power on any person authorised in writing in that behalf by the Committee to give the like permission.]

[Temporary closure of parking places.

6B. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of any order made under the provisions of section 1 of this Ordinance, the Chief Officer of Police or the

Committee may in their respective discretion close for any temporary continuous period not exceeding one month any disc parking place or approved parking place by exhibiting or causing to be exhibited thereon in such a manner as to be clearly visible to a person intending to park a vehicle or motor bicycle thereon a notice stating that the disc parking place or approved parking place, as the case may be, is temporarily closed and is not available for the parking of vehicles or motor bicycles and may in their respective discretion re-open such disc parking place or approved parking place by the removal of the said notice:

Provided that where the closure of any disc parking place or approved parking place under the provisions of this section exceeds or is intended to exceed the period of ten days, the Chief Officer of Police or the Committee, as the case may be, shall publish a notice in "La Gazette Officielle" giving particulars of the closure.

(2) A person, being in charge of a vehicle or motor bicycle, shall not park that vehicle or motor bicycle, as the case may be, in any disc parking place or approved parking place in respect of which a notice of closure is exhibited thereon in accordance with the provisions of subsection (1) of this section.]

[Section 6C.

6C. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of any order made under section 1(d) of this Ordinance, and subject to the provisions of subsection (2) hereof, the Committee may at its discretion by order alter the period during which a person may park a vehicle or motor bicycle in a disc parking place or an approved parking place for any continuous period not exceeding one month.

(2) No order shall be made under subsection (1) unless the Committee has published on one occasion in La Gazette Officielle a notice giving particulars of the proposed alteration.

(3) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 4, a person being in charge of a vehicle or motor bicycle shall not, for the duration of the period specified in an order made under subsection (1), allow that vehicle to remain parked in a disc parking place or an approved parking place for any continuous period greater than that prescribed in such order.]

Offences.

7. Any person who –
- (a) contravenes the provisions of [section 3, section 4, section 4A(2) section 4B or section 6B(2)] of this Ordinance, or
 - (b) contravenes the provisions of an order made under the provisions of section one of this Ordinance or fails to comply with any condition prescribed in any such order, or
 - (c) parks a vehicle in a disc parking place and knowingly sets the clock [...] of the parking disc fixed to the vehicle in such manner as to indicate an incorrect time of arrival, or

- (d) with intent to deceive, alters the clock [setting] of a parking disc fixed to a vehicle parked in a disc parking place,

shall be guilty of an offence and liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding [level 1 on the uniform scale] and, on a second or any subsequent conviction, to a fine not exceeding [level 2 on the uniform scale].

In accordance with the provisions of the Offences (Fixed Penalties) (Guernsey) Law, 2009, section 1, section 2 and the Schedule, with effect from 1st July, 2012, any liability to conviction of offences against section 7 of this Ordinance may be discharged by payment of a fixed penalty.⁵

Interpretation.

8. In this Ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, that is to say –

["**Chief Officer of Police**" means the Chief Officer of the Island Police Force,]

"park" means the stationing on a public highway of a vehicle or a motor bicycle, as the case may be, whether attended or unattended, but does not include the stopping of a vehicle or a motor bicycle to set down or pick up passengers [and the expression **"re-park"** shall be construed accordingly,]

"parking disc" means a parking disc of such type as may, from time to time, be approved by the Committee,

"public highway" includes any road, street, lane or public place,

"vehicle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on the public highway and includes a motor bicycle combination and a motor tricycle but does not include a motor bicycle.

NOTE

In section 8, the definition of the expression "Chief Officer of Police", and the words in square brackets in the definition of the expression "park", were inserted by the Road Traffic (Parking Places) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1988, respectively section 1(h)(i) and section 1(h)(ii), with effect from 26th October, 1988, subject to the savings in section 4 and section 5 of the 1988 Ordinance.

Repeals.

9. The Ordinances set out in the left hand column of the Schedule to this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent set out in the right hand column thereof.

Citation.

[10. This Ordinance may be cited as the Road Traffic (Parking Places) Ordinance, 1963.]
