**The Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-way Streets) (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1954.**

THE STATES, on the representations of the Island Police Committee, hereby order:—

1. Immediately after paragraph 21 of the Second Schedule to the Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets) Ordinance, 1951, as amended, there are hereby inserted the following additional paragraphs numbered 22, 23 and 24 respectively:—

- “ 22. That portion of Guelles Road, St. Peter Port, from its junction with Amherst to Amherst Schools, from South to North.
23. That portion of Amherst, St. Peter Port, from its junction with Rouge Rue to its junction with Guelles Road, from North to South.
24. That portion of Rue Maurepas, St. Peter Port, from its junction with Guelles Road to the junction of Rouge Rue with Mont Arrivé from West to East.”

2. Section four of the Prohibited Streets (Bicycles) Ordinance, 1954, is hereby repealed.

3. This Ordinance, the Prohibited Streets (Bicycles) Ordinance, 1954, the Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-way Streets) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1954, and the Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-way Streets) Ordinances, 1951 and 1952 may be cited together as the Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-way Streets) Ordinances, 1951 to 1954.

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 26th day of December, 1954.
