**The Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-way
Streets) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1954.**

(No. XIV—
1954)

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 7th day of July, 1954, hereby order:—

1. The Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-way Streets) Ordinance, 1951, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:—

(a) in the First Schedule thereto immediately after paragraph 4 there shall be inserted the following additional paragraph numbered 5—

Part of
La Rue des
Frères a
Prohibited
Street.

“ 5. That portion of La Rue des Frères which lies between Upland Road and St. Julian’s Avenue, St. Peter Port.”;

(b) in the Second Schedule thereto paragraph 14 is hereby deleted and the following paragraph numbered 14 is substituted therefor—

Part of Le
Mont
Durand a
One-way
Street.

“ 14. That portion of Le Mont Durand, St. Peter Port, between Valnord Road and Upper Mansell Street, downwards.”.
