**The Road Traffic (Prohibited and  
One-way Streets (Ordinance, 1952.**

THE STATES, on the representations of the Island  
Police Committee, hereby order:—

1. The Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way  
Streets) Ordinance, 1951, is hereby amended by the  
insertion after paragraph twenty-one of the Second  
Schedule thereto of a new paragraph twenty-two in  
the following terms:—

“22. Rue du Manoir (~~Court Row~~), Saint Peter  
Port, from South to North.”

2. This Ordinance and the Road Traffic (Prohibited  
and One-Way Streets) Ordinances, 1951, may be cited  
together as the Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way  
Streets) Ordinances, 1951 and 1952.

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 1st  
day of May, 1952.
