**The Road Traffic (Speed Limits and
General Provisions) (Amendment) (No. 2)
Ordinance, 1970**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-sixth day of March, nineteen hundred and sixty-nine, hereby order:—

1. Subsection (1) of section five of the Road Traffic (Speed Limits and General Provisions) Ordinance, 1955, as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”)(a), is hereby repealed and the following subsection is hereby substituted therefor:—

“ (1) Subject to the provisions of this section, a person shall not on any public highway drive a motor vehicle exceeding two tons unladen weight at a speed exceeding twenty-five miles per hour.”.

2. In section thirteen of the principal Ordinance the words “five pounds” and “ten pounds” are hereby repealed and the words “ten pounds” and

“fifty pounds” are hereby respectively substituted therefor.

Repeal.

3. Section one of the Road Traffic (Speed Limits and Pedestrian Crossings) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1964, is hereby repealed.

Citation and collective title.

4. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Road Traffic (Speed Limits and General Provisions) (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1970.

(2) This Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may be cited together as the Road Traffic (Speed Limits and General Provisions) Ordinances, 1955 and 1970.

Commencement.

5. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of December, nineteen hundred and seventy.
