**The Road Traffic (Speed Limits and  
General Provisions) (Amendment)  
Ordinance, 1970**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-ninth day of September, nineteen hundred and seventy, hereby order:—

1. In paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section three of the Road Traffic (Speed Limits and General Provisions) Ordinance, 1955, as amended (a), the full-stop after the words “New Road in the parish of Saint Sampson” is hereby deleted and a semi-colon is substituted therefor and immediately thereafter there are hereby inserted the following words:—

“Bridge Road from its junction with New Road in the parish of Saint Sampson to its junction with Vale Avenue in the parish of the Vale;

Vale Avenue in the parish of the Vale from its junction with Bridge Road to its junction with Braye Road;
