Coming into Operation ... 1st April, 1973.

The Road Traffic (Speed Limits and General Provisions) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1973

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-eighth day of September, nineteen hundred and seventy-two, hereby order:—

1. Section three of the Road Traffic (Speed Limits and General Provisions) Ordinance, 1955, as amended^(a), is hereby repealed and the following section is substituted therefor—

“ 3. (1) Subject to the provisions of this Ordinance, a person shall not drive or ride a vehicle at a speed exceeding twenty-five miles per hour—

(a) on any public highway in the parishes of Saint Peter Port and Saint Martin situate within the area bounded by the following public highways—

 Avenue to its junction with Les Croutes;
 Les Croutes, from its junction with Route
 Isabelle to its junction with Rue à L'Or
 and King's Road;
 Rue à L'Or;
 Le Vauquiédor, from its junction with Rue
 à L'Or to its junction with Mount Row
 and Richmond Avenue;
 Mount Row;
 Prince Albert's Road;
 Colborne Road;
 Le Val des Terres;
 South Esplanade;
 The Quay;
 North Esplanade;
 Glatigny Esplanade;
 St. George's Esplanade; and
 Les Banques, from its junction with St.
 George's Esplanade to its junction with
 Grand Bouet;

other than the following public highways—

Market Street;
 Market Place;
 Mill Street;

Mansell Street;
 Church Square;
 High Street;
 Smith Street;
 The Pollet;

- (b) on any of the public highways in the parishes of Saint Peter Port and Saint Martin mentioned in the last preceding paragraph as forming the boundary of the area specified in that paragraph, other than the following public highways—

Glategny Esplanade;

St. George's Esplanade;

Les Banques, from its junction with St. George's Esplanade to its junction with Grand Bouet;

- (c) on any of the following public highways—

- (i) in the parish of Saint Peter Port—

The Castle Emplacement;

The bridge connecting the Castle Emplacement with the Castle Breakwater;

The Albert Pier;

The Victoria Pier;

St. Julian's Pier;

The Cambridge Pier;

The New Jetty;

The White Rock;

- (ii) in the parish of Saint Sampson—

Grandes Maisons Road;

New Road;

Church Road;

- South Side, from its junction with New Road to its junction with Bulwer Avenue;
 Nocq Road;
- (iii) in the parishes of Saint Sampson and the Vale—
 Bridge Road;
- (iv) in the parish of the Vale—
 Vale Avenue;
- (v) in the parish of the Castel—
 Les Delisles, from Les Delisles Chapel to its junction with Rue de la Porte; Rue de la Porte;
 King's Mills Road, from its junction with Rue de la Porte to its junction with La Hurette Road;
- (vi) in the parish of Saint Martin—
 La Route des Camps, from the Queen's Hotel to its junction with La Grande Rue;
 La Grande Rue, from its junction with La Route des Camps to its junction with Rue des Câches and La Rue Cauchez.

(2) A person shall not, during the period commencing on the first day of June and ending on the thirtieth day of September, both days inclusive, in each year, drive or ride a vehicle at a speed exceeding twenty-five miles per hour on any of the following public highways in the parish of the Castel—

Cobo Coast Road, from its junction with Route de Carteret to its junction with La Neuve Rue;

La Neuve Rue;

La Banquette;
 La Giffardière;
 Rue d'Albecq;
 Vazon Road, from its junction with Rue
 d'Albecq to the Martello Tower in Vazon
 Road.

(3) A person shall not drive or ride a vehicle at a speed exceeding fifteen miles per hour on the public highway of La Vallette in the parish of Saint Peter Port.

(4) A person shall not drive or ride a vehicle at a speed exceeding twelve miles per hour on any of the following public highways in the parish of Saint Peter Port—

Market Street;
 Market Place;
 Mill Street;
 Mansell Street;
 Church Square;
 High Street;
 Smith Street;
 The Pollet.”.

2. The Ordinances set out in the left-hand column of the Schedule to this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent set out in the right-hand column of that Schedule. **Repeals.**

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Road Traffic (Speed Limits and General Provisions) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1973. **Citation.**

4. This Ordinance, the Road Traffic (Speed Limits and General Provisions) (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1970, the Road Traffic (Speed Limits and **Collective title.**

General Provisions) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1962, and the Road Traffic (Speed Limits and General Provisions) Ordinance, 1955, may be cited together as the Road Traffic (Speed Limits and General Provisions) Ordinances, 1955 to 1973.

5. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of April, nineteen hundred and seventy-three.
