**The Road Traffic (Speed Limits and  
General Provisions) (Amendment)  
Ordinance, 1974**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-fifth day of September, nineteen hundred and seventy-four, hereby order:—

1. In subsection (2) of section six of the Road Traffic (Speed Limits and General Provisions) Ordinance, 1955, as amended<sup>(a)</sup>—

- (i) the words “, other than section two, ” are hereby repealed; and
- (ii) immediately after the words “for the purpose for which it is being so used” there are hereby inserted the words “and if the driver of the vehicle sounds the warning apparatus fitted to the vehicle”.
