**The Road Traffic (Speed Limits and
General Provisions) (Amendment)
Ordinance, 1985**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 10th day of July, 1985, hereby order:—

1. In section 3 of the Road Traffic (Speed Limits and General Provisions) Ordinance, 1955^(a), for subsection (2) there is substituted the following subsection:

“(2) A person shall not, during the period commencing on the first day of June and ending on the thirtieth day of September, both days inclusive, in each year, drive or ride a vehicle at a speed exceeding twenty-five miles per hour on any of the following public highways—

- (a) in the Parish of the Castel—
 Cobo Coast Road, from its junction
 with Route de Carteret to its junction
 with La Neuve Rue;
 La Neuve Rue;
 La Banquette;
 La Giffardière;
 Rue d'Albecq;
 Vazon Road, from its junction with
 Rue d'Albecq to the Martello Tower
 in Vazon Road;
- (b) in the Parish of Saint Peter-in-the-
 Wood—
 Route de Rocquaine, between its junc-
 tion with the Route de la Lague and
 its junction with the Route du Coudré;
- (c) in the Parishes of Saint Peter-in-the-
 Wood and Torteval—
 Route de la Lague.”.

- Citation. 2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Road
 Traffic (Speed Limits and General Provisions)
 (Amendment) Ordinance, 1985.
- Collective
 title. 3. This Ordinance and the Road Traffic (Speed
 Limits and General Provisions) Ordinances, 1955 to
 1984 may be cited together as the Road Traffic
 (Speed Limits and General Provisions) Ordinances,
 1955 to 1985.
- Commence-
 ment. 4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the
 1st day of August, 1985.
