**The Road Traffic (Speed Limits and Trailers) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1965**

THE STATES, on the representations of the Island Police Committee, hereby order:—

1. Immediately after section three of the Road Traffic (Speed Limits and Trailers) Ordinance, 1959 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”) there is hereby inserted the following marginal heading and additional section numbered “3A” :—

“Penalties. 3A. Any person who contravenes or attempts to contravene any of the provisions of the last two preceding sections shall be guilty of an offence and liable, on conviction, in the case of a first offence to a fine not exceeding five pounds, and in the case of a second or subsequent offence to a fine not exceeding ten pounds.”

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Road Traffic (Speed Limits and Trailers) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1965, and this Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may be cited together as the Road Traffic (Speed Limits and Trailers) Ordinances, 1959 and 1965.
