Ordinance of the States **VI** 1989

Made 26th April, 1989.
Coming into Operation ... 1st June, 1989.

The Road Traffic (Transfer of Functions) Ordinance, 1989

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 28th day of September, 1988, hereby order:—

1. (1) The functions of the Chief Officer of the Island Police arising under or by virtue of the Road Traffic (Speed Limits and Trailers) Ordinance, 1959(a) are transferred to and vested in the Committee. Transfer of Functions.

(2) The functions of the Island Police Committee in the Road Traffic (Construction and Use of Motor Vehicles) Ordinance, 1970(b) are transferred to and vested in the Committee.

2. In this Ordinance “the Committee” means the Island Traffic Committee, or such other Committee or like body of the States as the States may from time to time prescribe by Resolution under this section. Interpretation.

Savings.

3. (1) Nothing done by or in relation to the Chief Officer of the Island Police under or by virtue of the Ordinance referred to in section 1(1) before the commencement of this Ordinance shall be invalidated by such commencement.

(2) Nothing done by or in relation to the Island Police Committee under or by virtue of the Ordinance referred to in section 1(2) before the commencement of this Ordinance shall be invalidated by such commencement.

Amendments to Ordinances of 1959 and 1972.

4. (1) In section 3 of the Road Traffic (Speed Limits and Trailers) Ordinance, 1959(a), delete the words "the Chief Officer of the Island Police" and substitute "the Island Traffic Committee".

(2) In section 9 of the Road Traffic (Construction and Use of Motor Vehicles) Ordinance 1970, as amended(b), for the definition of "the Committee" substitute "means the Island Traffic Committee".

Citation.

5. This Ordinance may be cited as the Road Traffic (Transfer of Functions) Ordinance, 1989.

Commencement.

6. This Ordinance shall come into force on 1st June, 1989.
