The Road Traffic Temporary Regulations and Clearways (Amendment) Ordinance, 1990

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 29th March 1990(a), hereby order:—

1. (1) In sections (1) and (2) of Article X of the Ordinance entitled “Ordonnance relative au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile” of 2nd March, 1929(b) for “The Committee” there is substituted “The Island Traffic Committee”.

Temporary
Regulations.

(2) In the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950(c)—

(a) in section 1, for “the Island Police Committee” there is substituted “the Island Traffic Committee”;

(b) in section 2, for “six months” there is substituted “twelve months”.

(3) Any regulations made by the Island Police Committee before the commencement of this Ordinance and in force on 29th April 1989 are deemed to have been made by the Island Traffic Committee and as if this Ordinance (including paragraph (2)(b) of this section) had been in force when the regulations were made.

(4) So much of the Road Traffic (Parking and Temporary Regulations) Ordinance, 1962(d) as has not already been repealed is hereby repealed.

Clearways.

2. (1) In each of the Clearways Ordinances:

(a) in section 1, for "Chief Officer" there is substituted "Committee" and for "wait" there is substituted "stop";

(b) section 4 is renumbered as "4(1)" and for the definition of "Chief Officer" there is substituted:

" "the Committee" means the Island Traffic Committee;";

(c) immediately after section 4(1) there is inserted:

" (2) For the purposes of this Ordinance a vehicle or animal is caused or permitted to "stop" if it is stationary other than so as to comply with a legal requirement or to avoid a collision or interference with another vehicle or animal, or with a person."

(2) In column 2 of the Schedule to the Traffic Offences (Fixed Penalties) Ordinance, 1989(e) against the reference to each of the Clearways Ordinances, for "waiting" there is substituted "stopping".

(3) In this section “the Clearways Ordinances” means the Road Traffic (Lower Vauvert) (Clearway) Ordinance, 1984(*f*), the Road Traffic (Bordage) (Clearway) Ordinance, 1984(*g*) and the Road Traffic (Fountain Street) (Clearway) Ordinance, 1984(*h*).

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Road Traffic Temporary Regulations and Clearways (Amendment) Ordinance, 1990. Citation.

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on 30th April 1990. Commencement.
