ORDER IN COUNCIL



IN THE ROYAL COURT OF THE ISLAND OF GUERNSEY

The 20th day of August, 1985 before Sir Charles Frossard, Kt., Bailiff, present:—Albert Richard McCartney Straw, Donald Pescott Plummer, Brian Ernest Herbert Joy, Esquires, Charles Henry Hodder, Esquire, O.B.E., Harry Wilson Bisson, Herbert Nicolle Machon, James de Sausmarez Carey, John Christopher Bulstrode, Geoffrey Ernest Le Page and Stanley Walter John Jehan, Esquires, Jurats.

The Bailiff having this day placed before the Court an Order of Her Majesty in Council dated the 25th June 1985 approving and ratifying a *Projet de Loi* of the States of Guernsey entitled "The Social Insurance (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1985", the Court, after having heard Her Majesty's Procureur thereon, ordered that the said Order in Council be registered on the records of this Island and that an extract of this present Act, together with a copy of the said Order in Council be sent by Her Majesty's Greffier to the Clerk of the Court of Alderney for registration on the records of that Island, of which Order in Council the tenor followeth:—

PRESENT,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

WHEREAS there was this day read at the Board a Report from the Right Honourable the Lords of the Committee of Council for the Affairs of Guernsey and Jersey dated the 14th day of June 1985 in the words following, viz.:—

“YOUR MAJESTY having been pleased, by Your General Order of Reference of the 22nd day of February 1952, to refer unto this Committee the humble Petition of the States of the Island of Guernsey setting forth:—

‘1. That in pursuance of their Resolution of the 28th day of November 1984 the States of Deliberation, at a meeting held on the 14th day of March 1985, approved a Bill or “Projet de Loi” entitled “The Social Insurance (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1985”, and requested the Bailiff to present a most humble Petition to Your Majesty in Council praying for Your Royal Sanction thereto. 2. That the said Bill or “Projet de Loi” is as set forth in the schedule hereunto annexed and most humbly praying that Your Majesty might be graciously pleased to grant Your Royal Sanction to the Bill or “Projet de Loi” of the States of Guernsey entitled “The Social Insurance (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1985”, and to order that the same shall have force of law in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.’

“THE LORDS OF THE COMMITTEE, in obedience to Your Majesty’s said Order of Reference, have taken the said Petition and the said Projet de Loi into consideration and do this day agree humbly to report, as their opinion to Your Majesty, that it may be advisable for Your Majesty to comply with the prayer of the said Petition and to approve of and ratify the said Projet de Loi”.

HER MAJESTY having taken the said Report into consideration is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to approve of and ratify the said Projet de Loi, and to order, and it is hereby ordered, that the same shall have the force of Law within the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

AND HER MAJESTY doth hereby further direct that this Order, and the said Projet de Loi (a copy whereof is hereunto annexed), be entered upon the Register of the Island of Guernsey and observed accordingly.

AND the Lieutenant Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Island of Guernsey, the Bailiff and Jurats, and all other Her Majesty’s Officers for the time being in the said Island, and all other persons whom it may concern, are to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.

PROJET DE LOI

ENTITLED

**The Social Insurance (Amendment)
(Guernsey) Law, 1985**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 28th day of November, 1984, have approved the following provisions which, subject to the Sanction of Her Most Excellent Majesty in Council, shall have force of law in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

1. Section 6(3) of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, as amended^(a), is hereby repealed and the following subsection is hereby substituted therefor—

“(3) Where any person who, but for this subsection, would be liable to pay Class 2 contributions under and in accordance with the last foregoing subsection as respects any contribution year or part of a contribution year has satisfied the Authority that his relevant earnings are below the current upper annual earnings limit for that year in respect of Class 2 contributions and has satisfied such other conditions as may be prescribed, then, subject to and in accordance with regulations, he shall be liable to pay a Class 2 contribution in respect of each contribution week in that year or part of that year, as the case may be, at such reduced rate as shall be prescribed.”.

Citation. 2. This Law may be cited as the Social Insurance (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1985.

Collective title. 3. This Law and the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Laws, 1978 to 1982, may be cited together as the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Laws, 1978 to 1985.
