ORDER IN COUNCIL



IN THE ROYAL COURT OF THE ISLAND OF GUERNSEY

The 17th day of February, 1987 before Sir Charles Frossard, Kt., Bailiff; present:—Donald Pescott Plummer, Brian Ernest Herbert Joy, Esquires, Charles Henry Hodder, Esquire, O.B.E., Harry Wilson Bisson, Herbert Nicolle Machon, James de Sausmarez Carey, John Christopher Bulstrode, Stanley Walter John Jehan, Raymond Arthur Heaume and Leonard Arthur Moss, Esquires, Jurats.

The Bailiff having this day placed before the Court an Order of Her Majesty in Council dated the 16th day of December, 1986, approving and ratifying a Projet de Loi entitled "The Social Insurance (Amendment) (No. 2) (Guernsey) Law, 1986", the Court, after the reading of the said Order in Council and after having heard Her Majesty's Procureur thereon, ordered that the said Order in Council be registered on the records of this Island and that an extract of this present Act, together with a copy of the said Order in Council, be sent by Her Majesty's Greffier to the Clerk of the Court of Alderney for registration on the records of that Island, of which Order in Council the tenor followeth:—

PRESENT,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

WHEREAS there was this day read at the Board a Report from the Right Honourable the Lords of the Committee of Council for the Affairs of Guernsey and Jersey dated the 10th day of December 1986 in the words following, viz.:—

“YOUR MAJESTY having been pleased, by Your General Order of Reference of the 22nd day of February 1952, to refer unto this Committee the humble Petition of the States of the Island of Guernsey, setting forth:—

‘1. That in pursuance of their Resolution of the 31st day of July 1986 the States of Deliberation at a meeting held on the 24th day of September 1986 approved a Bill or “Projet de Loi” entitled “The Social Insurance (Amendment) (No. 2) (Guernsey) Law, 1986”, and requested the Bailiff to present a most humble Petition to Your Majesty in Council praying for Your Royal Sanction thereto. 2. That the said Bill or “Projet de Loi” is as set forth in the Schedule hereunto annexed. And most humbly praying that Your Majesty might be graciously pleased to grant Your Royal Sanction to the Bill or “Projet de Loi” of the States of Guernsey entitled “The Social Insurance (Amendment) (No. 2) (Guernsey) Law, 1986”,

and to order that the same shall have force of law in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.’


“THE LORDS OF THE COMMITTEE, in obedience to Your Majesty’s said Order of Reference, have taken the said Petition and the said Projet de Loi into consideration, and do this day agree humbly to report, as their opinion, to Your Majesty, that it may be advisable for Your Majesty to comply with the prayer of the said Petition and to approve of and ratify the said Projet de Loi.”

HER MAJESTY having taken the said Report into consideration is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to approve of and ratify the said Projet de Loi, and to order, and it is hereby ordered, that the same shall have the force of Law within the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

AND HER MAJESTY doth hereby further direct that this Order, and the said Projet de Loi (a copy whereof is hereunto annexed), be entered upon the Register of the Island of Guernsey and observed accordingly.

AND the Lieutenant Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Island of Guernsey, the Bailiff and Jurats, and all other Her Majesty’s Officers for the time being in the said Island, and all other persons whom it may concern, are to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.

PROJET DE LOI

ENTITLED

**The Social Insurance (Amendment)
(No. 2) (Guernsey) Law, 1986**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 31st day of July, 1986, have approved the following provisions which, subject to the Sanction of Her Most Excellent Majesty in Council, shall have force of law in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

1. The Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, as amended^(a), is hereby further amended as follows:— Amend-
ments to
Law of 1978.

- (a) in section 13(2) thereof the words “fifty pounds” are repealed and the words “four hundred pounds” are substituted therefor;
- (b) in section 103(4) thereof the words “fifty pounds” are repealed and the words “four hundred pounds” are substituted therefor;
- (c) in section 103(5) thereof the words “ten pounds” are repealed and the words “twenty pounds” are substituted therefor;
- (d) in section 104(1) thereof the words “fifty pounds” are repealed and the words “one thousand pounds” are substituted therefor;
- (e) immediately after subsection (1) of section 104 thereof there is inserted the following additional subsection numbered “(1A)”—

(a) Ordres en Conseil Vol. XXVI, p. 292; No. IV of 1980; No. VII of 1981; No. I of 1982; No. IV of 1985; No. III of 1986.

“(1A) Where any primary Class I or secondary Class I contribution, or any part thereof, payable by an employer to the Authority under this Law in respect of a person employed by him (in this subsection referred to as “the outstanding contribution”) is not paid to the Authority on or before the prescribed date (in this subsection referred to as “the due date”), there shall be payable by such employer to the Authority in addition to the outstanding contribution—

- (a) a penalty equivalent to the sum of two and a half per centum of the outstanding contribution; and
- (b) interest on the outstanding contribution calculated at the rate of two and a half per centum per month from the due date until the outstanding contribution shall be paid;

and any such penalty and interest may be recovered by the Authority as part of the outstanding contribution.”;

- (f) in section 104(2) thereof the words “four hundred pounds” are repealed and the words “two thousand pounds” are substituted therefor;

(g) in section 104(3)(a) thereof the words “one hundred pounds” are repealed and the words “four hundred pounds” are substituted therefor;

(h) in section 104(3)(b) the words “ten pounds” are repealed and the words “twenty pounds” are substituted therefor.

2. Section 4 of the Social Insurance (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1986(b), is hereby repealed. **Repeal.**

3. This Law may be cited as the Social Insurance (Amendment) (No. 2) (Guernsey) Law, 1986. **Citation.**

4. This Law, the Social Insurance (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1986, the Social Insurance (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1985(c) and the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Laws, 1978 to 1982, may be cited together as the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Laws, 1978 to 1986. **Collective title.**
