**The Social Insurance  
(Assignment of Rights of Action)  
(Prescribed Notices) (Guernsey)  
Ordinance, 1965**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section sixty-nine of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964, hereby order:—

1. (1) A notice under subsection (1) of section sixty-nine of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964 (which relates to the assignment to the States Insurance Authority of rights against third parties in certain cases) relating to the injury or death of any person shall be—

Forms of notice under sub-section (1) of section sixty-nine of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964.

- (a) in the case where the notice is intended to be served on the President of the States Insurance Authority by the injured person himself, in Form 1 as set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance;

- (b) in the case where the notice is intended to be so served by the legal personal representatives of that person, in Form 2 as set out in the said Schedule;
  - (c) in the case where the notice is intended to be served by the guardian of that person, in Form 3 as set out in the said Schedule.
- (2) Any form set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance may be used with such variation as the circumstances may require.

Extent, construction and citation.

2. (1) This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Ordinance throughout the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

(3) This Ordinance may be cited as the Social Insurance (Assignment of Rights of Action) (Prescribed Notices) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1965.
