**The Social Insurance (Increases in Rates
of Old Age Pensions) (Guernsey)
Ordinance, 1972**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (5) of section nineteen and subsection (3) of section twenty of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964, as amended(*a*), and by section one of the Social Insurance (Amendment) (No. 3) (Guernsey) Law, 1971(*b*), hereby order:—

1. (1) In this Ordinance, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, that is to say:—

“the Law of 1964” means the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964;

“reckonable contributions” means contributions which are to be taken into account for the

purpose of the provisions of sub-section (5) of section nineteen of the Law of 1964 (which subsection provides for increasing the weekly rate of an old age pension by reference to contributions paid by a person who has elected to be treated as if he were not entitled to an old age pension) and for the purpose of sub-section (3) of section twenty of the Law of 1964 (which subsection relates to an old age pension payable to a woman by virtue of her husband's insurance);

and any other expressions have the same meaning as in the Law of 1964.

(2) Except where the context otherwise requires, any reference in this Ordinance to any other enactment shall be construed as including a reference to that enactment as amended, repealed, replaced or revoked by or under any other enactment including this Ordinance.

(3) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948(c), shall apply to the interpretation of this Ordinance throughout the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

2. In subsection (5) of section nineteen of the Law of 1964 the words "ten new pence" are hereby repealed and the words "twelve new pence" are hereby substituted therefor.

3. In paragraph (a) and in paragraph (b) of sub-section (3) of section twenty of the Law of 1964 the words "five new pence" are hereby repealed and the words "six new pence" are hereby substituted therefor.

4. For the purposes of subsection (5) of section nineteen and subsection (3) of section twenty of the Law of 1964, any reckonable contributions paid for contribution weeks before the sixth day of December, nineteen hundred and seventy-one, and which do not on that day make up nine or a multiple of nine contributions, shall be treated as if they had been paid for contribution weeks commencing on or after that date.

5. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Social Insurance (Increases in Rates of Old Age Pensions) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1972.

(2) This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

(3) This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into force on the sixth day of December, nineteen hundred and seventy-one.
