## **The Social Insurance (Medical Certification) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1972**

**THE STATES**, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (6) of section forty-eight and subsection (3) of section seventy-seven of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964, as amended<sup>a</sup>, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order: –

### **Amendment of principal Ordinance, as amended.**

**1.** (1) The Social Insurance (Medical Certification) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1968, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance"<sup>b</sup>), is hereby further amended, as follows, that is to say –

- (a) in subsection (1) of section two thereof, there is hereby inserted, immediately before the word "confinement", the word "expected",
- (b) subsection (2) of section four thereof is hereby repealed.

(2) Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this section, the provisions of the principal Ordinance having effect immediately before the commencement of this Ordinance in relation to a woman who claims sickness benefit by reason of her confinement, shall continue to have effect in relation to a woman who has been confined and who claims sickness benefit in respect of any day which

is deemed to be a day of incapacity for work by virtue of the provisions of paragraph (2) of regulation one of the Social Insurance (Unemployment and Sickness Benefit) (Amendment) (No. 3) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1971, in all respects as if this Ordinance had not been enacted.

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**NOTES**

*In accordance with the provisions of the Social Insurance (Collection of Contributions) (Transfer of Functions) Regulations, 2018, regulation 1, with effect from 22nd October, 2018 and subject to the savings and transitional provisions in regulation 3, the functions, rights and liabilities of the Committee for Employment & Social Security and of its President and members relating to the collection of social insurance contributions arising under or by virtue of this Ordinance were transferred to and vested in, respectively, the Policy & Resources Committee and its President and members; and, in accordance with regulation 2 of the 2018 Regulations, for any reference herein to the Committee for Employment & Social Security or its President or members, however expressed, there was substituted, to the extent that the reference related to the collection of social insurance contributions, a reference to the Policy & Resources Committee or (as the case may be) its President or members.*

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**Citation, construction, collective title and extent.**

2. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Social Insurance (Medical Certification) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1972.

(2) This Ordinance and the principal Ordinance shall be construed as one.

*Consolidated text*

(3) This Ordinance and the Social Insurance (Medical Certification) (Guernsey) Ordinances, 1968 and 1971, may be cited together as the Social Insurance (Medical Certification) (Guernsey) Ordinances, 1968 to 1972.

(4) This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.
