**The Social Insurance (Rates of Contributions and Benefits, etc.) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1980**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-fourth day of September, nineteen hundred and eighty, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section nineteen and section fifty-seven of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978(a), and in exercise of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. The Social Insurance (Rates of Contributions and Benefits, etc.) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1980(b), is hereby amended as follows:— Amendment of Ordinance of 1980.

- (a) subsection (2) of section eight thereof is repealed;
- (b) Part I of the Schedule thereto is repealed and the Part I set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance is substituted therefor.

Extent.            2. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

Citation and Collective title.    3. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Social Insurance (Rates of Contributions and Benefits, etc.) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1980.

(2) This Ordinance, the Social Insurance (Rates of Contributions and Benefits, etc.) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1980, the Social Insurance (Rates of Contributions and Benefits, etc.) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1979 and the Social Insurance (Rates of Contributions and Benefits, etc.) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1978, may be cited together as the Social Insurance (Rates of Contributions and Benefits, etc.) (Guernsey) Ordinances, 1978 to 1980.

Commencement.    4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the fifth day of January, nineteen hundred and eighty-one.
