Ordinance of the States **I**

1985

Made 30th January, 1985.

Came into Operation ... 1st January, 1985.

The Social Insurance (Reciprocal Agreement with the United States of America) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1985

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 113 of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, as amended^(a), and on the representations of the States Insurance Authority, hereby order:—

1. The provisions contained in the Agreement shall have full force and effect and the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, shall have effect subject to such modifications as may be required therein for the purpose of giving effect to any such provisions: Provided—

Modifica-
tion of Law.

- (a) that the provisions contained in the Agreement, other than in Part III thereof, shall be deemed to have entered into force on the 1st day of January, 1985; and

(b) that the provisions contained in Part III of the Agreement shall enter into force on the 1st day of January, 1988.

Interpretation.

2. (1) In this Ordinance the expression "the Agreement" means the Agreement on Social Security between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the United States of America done at London on the 13th day of February, 1984, and includes the Administrative Agreement for the implementation of the aforesaid Agreement on Social Security done at London on the 13th day of February, 1984, registered on the records of the Island of Guernsey on the 27th day of November, 1984.

(2) Any reference in this Ordinance to any other enactment shall, except where the context otherwise requires, be construed as including a reference to that enactment as amended, repealed or replaced, extended or applied by or under any other enactment including this Ordinance.

Repeal.

3. The Social Insurance (Reciprocal Agreement with the United States of America) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1970(b), is hereby repealed:

Provided that in accordance with the provisions contained in the Agreement—

(a) any right to benefit acquired by a person in accordance with the provisions of the Ordinance hereby repealed shall be maintained; and

(b) Recueil d'Ordonnances Tome XVI, p. 444.

(b) a person shall not suffer any loss of rights which he has under the provisions of the Ordinance hereby repealed or any such rights he would have had if the Ordinance hereby repealed had not been replaced by this Ordinance.

4. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands ^{Extent.}
of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

5. This Ordinance may be cited as the Social ^{Citation.}
Insurance (Reciprocal Agreement with the United
States of America) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1985.

6. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come ^{Commence-}
