The Social Insurance (Reports by Actuary) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1972

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-ninth day of March, nineteen hundred and seventy-two, and in exercise of the powers conferred on them by the Proviso to subsection (1) of section forty-six of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964, as amended^(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. The period ending on the thirtieth day of December, nineteen hundred and seventy-two to be covered by a review and report under subsection (1) of section forty-six of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964, as amended, shall be reduced by six months to a period ending on the thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and seventy-two, and the making of that and subsequent reviews and reports under the said subsection (1) shall be accelerated accordingly.

Reduction of period to be covered by actuarial review and report and acceleration of subsequent reviews and reports.
