

The Social Security (Reciprocal Agreement with Jamaica)
Ordinance, 1997

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 113 of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, as amended^a, hereby order:-

Reciprocal Agreement to have effect.

1. (1) The Convention between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of Jamaica on Social Security with Protocol, signed in London on the 12th November, 1996^b, shall have full force and effect.

(2) The Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, as amended shall have effect subject to such modifications as may be required for the purpose of giving effect to the said Convention.

Repeal.

2. The Social Insurance (Reciprocal Agreement with Jamaica) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1972^c is repealed.

Extent.

3. This Ordinance shall apply to the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

Citation.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Social Security (Reciprocal Agreement with Jamaica) Ordinance, 1997.

Commencement.

5. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1997.
