

The Social Security (Reciprocal Agreement with the United States of America) Ordinance, 1997

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 113 of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, as amended^a, hereby order:-

Reciprocal Agreement to have effect.

1. (1) The Agreement on Social Security between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the United States of America^b, including the Administrative Agreement for the Implementation of the aforesaid Agreement on Social Security, both done at London on the 13th February, 1984, as amended by the Supplementary Agreement amending the Agreement on Social Security between the said Governments with Supplementary Administrative Agreement done at London on the 6th June, 1996^c, shall have full force and effect.

(2) The Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, as amended shall have effect subject to such modifications as may be required for the purpose of giving effect to the said Agreement.

2. The Social Insurance (Reciprocal Agreement with the United States of America) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1985^d is repealed.

Extent.

3. This Ordinance shall apply to the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

Citation.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Social Security (Reciprocal Agreement with the United States of America) Ordinance, 1997.

Commencement.

5. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 25th June, 1997.
