Coming into Operation 1st April, 1969

**The Stamp Duty on Cheques (Abolition)
Ordinance, 1969**

THE STATES, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (1) of section one of the Indirect Taxes, Duties and Impôts (Guernsey) Law, 1962(a), and in pursuance of their Resolution of the thirtieth day of January, nineteen hundred and sixty-nine, hereby order:—

1. The following provisions of the Law entitled “Loi relative aux Droits de Timbre” registered on the sixteenth day of January, nineteen hundred and twenty-two, as amended(b), that is to say:—

- (b) paragraph 41 of the Schedule thereto;
- (c) paragraph 3 of the exemptions in the Schedule thereto;

are hereby repealed.

Citation. 2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Stamp Duty on Cheques (Abolition) Ordinance, 1969.

Commencement. 3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of April, nineteen hundred and sixty-nine.
