**The Stamp Duty on Documents
(Abolition) Ordinance, 1971**

THE STATES, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (1) of section one of the Indirect Taxes, Duties and Impôts (Guernsey) Law, 1962(a), and in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-eighth day of April, nineteen hundred and seventy-one, hereby order:—

1. The provisions of the Schedule to the Law entitled "Loi relative aux Droits de Timbre" registered on the sixteenth day of January, nineteen hundred and twenty-two, as amended(b), set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance are hereby repealed. Provisions of Stamp Duty Law repealed.
2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Stamp Citation.
