**The Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1974**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-ninth day of May, nineteen hundred and seventy-four, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (2) of section three of the Supplementary Benefit (Guernsey) Law, 1971(a), hereby order:—

1. The Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) Ordinance, 1971(b) (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”), as amended(c), is hereby further amended as follows, that is to say:—

- (a) sub-paragraph (3) of paragraph 3 of Part 1 of the First Schedule thereto is hereby repealed and the following sub-paragraph is hereby substituted therefor—

“(3) There shall be disregarded for the purposes of this paragraph—

- (a) any form of income mentioned in paragraphs 11, 13 or 14 of Part III of this Schedule;
  - (b) any amount by which any weekly earnings mentioned in paragraph 15 of the said Part III exceeds a multiple of five new pence; and
  - (c) any allowance payable under the Family Allowances (Guernsey) Law, 1950.”;
- (b) paragraph 5 of Part II of the First Schedule thereto is hereby repealed and the following paragraph is hereby substituted therefor—

“*Normal requirements*

5. The requirements of persons shall be as follows, that is to say:—

- (a) For a husband and wife or other persons falling within sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 2 of this Schedule ...£16.25
- (b) For a person living alone or a householder not falling within item (a) of this paragraph who is directly responsible for household necessities and rent (if any) ...£10.20
- (c) For any other person
  - (i) aged twenty years or over ... .. £8.40
  - (ii) aged eighteen years or over but less than twenty years ... .. £5.75

- (iii) aged sixteen years or over but less than eighteen years ... .. £5.15
- (iv) aged thirteen years or over but less than sixteen years ... .. £4.35
- (v) aged eleven years or over but less than thirteen years ... .. £3.55
- (vi) aged five years or over but less than eleven years ... .. £2.90
- (vii) aged less than five years £2.40”;
- (c) in item (b) of sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 6 of Part II of the First Schedule thereto, the words “seventy-five new pence” are hereby repealed and the words “one pound and fifty new pence” are hereby substituted therefor;
- (d) in sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 15 of Part III of the First Schedule thereto, the words “two pounds” are hereby repealed and the words “three pounds” are hereby substituted therefor.

2. The Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) Repeal (Amendment) Ordinance, 1974, is hereby repealed.

3. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1974.

(3) This Ordinance shall come into force on the eighth day of November, nineteen hundred and seventy-four.
