Ordinance of the States **XLI**
1988

Made 26th October, 1988.
Coming into Operation ... 18th November, 1988.

The Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1988

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 28th day of September, 1988, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 3(2) and section 15 of the Supplementary Benefit (Guernsey) Law, 1971(a), hereby order:—

1. The Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) Ordinance, 1971, as amended(b), is hereby further amended as follows:— Amendment of Ordinance of 1971.

(a) in section 26(1) thereof—

(i) immediately after the definition of the expression “the Law” there is inserted the following additional definition—

“ “nursing home” has the same meaning as in section 18(1) of the Nursing Homes and Residential Homes (Guernsey) Law, 1976;”;

- (ii) immediately after the definition of the expression “the Register” there is inserted the following additional definition—

“ “residential home” has the same meaning as in section 18(1) of the Nursing Homes and Residential Homes (Guernsey) Law, 1976;”;

- (b) sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 3 of Part I of the First Schedule thereto is repealed and the following sub-paragraph is substituted therefor—

“ (2) For the purpose of the last preceding sub-paragraph the limit of the weekly income—

- (a) of a person whose requirements are in accordance with paragraph 5 of this Schedule shall be £110;
- (b) of a person whose requirements are in accordance with paragraph 7 of this Schedule shall be £200.”;
- (c) in paragraph 7 of Part II of the First Schedule thereto the words “in a home for old people” are repealed and the words “in a residential home” are substituted therefor.

Repeals.

2. Section 5 of the Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1988(c), is hereby repealed.
