**The Supplementary Benefit (Implementation)  
(Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 2001**

**THE STATES**, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 26th day of September, 2001<sup>a</sup> and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 3(2) and 15 of the Supplementary Benefit (Guernsey) Law, 1971<sup>b</sup>, as amended, hereby order:-

**Amendment of Ordinance**

**1.** In the Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) Ordinance, 1971, as amended<sup>c</sup>-

(a) for paragraph 3(2) of the First Schedule substitute -

"(2) For the purposes of subparagraph (1) the limit of the weekly income -

(a) of a person whose requirements are in accordance with paragraphs 5 and 8 of this Schedule shall be £208.00;

(b) of a person who is residing in a residential home and whose requirements are in accordance with paragraph 7 of this Schedule shall be the sum of-

(i) a personal allowance of £16.50; and

(ii) £333.00;

(c) of a person who is residing in a hospital, a nursing home or the Guernsey Cheshire Home as a patient and whose requirements are in accordance with paragraph 7 of this Schedule shall be the sum of-

(i) a personal allowance of £16.50; and

(ii) £478.00.";

(b) for paragraphs 5(1) and (2) of the First Schedule substitute-

“(1) The requirements of persons who are continuously in need of a supplementary benefit for a period not exceeding 6 months shall be as follows-

(a) for a husband and wife or other persons falling within paragraph 2(1) of this Schedule, £125.90;

(b) for a person living alone or a householder not

falling within subparagraph (a) who is directly responsible for household necessities and rent (if any), £79.05;

(c) for any other person who is not a householder, £66.75

(d) for a member of a household -

(i) aged 16 years or over, £56.55;

(ii) aged 12 years or over but less than 16 years, £34.95;

(iii) aged 5 years or over but less than 12 years, £25.35;

(iv) aged less than 5 years, £18.70.

(2) The requirements of persons to whom a supplementary benefit has been payable for a continuous period of 6 months shall be as follows -

(a) for a husband and wife or other persons falling within paragraph 2(1) of this Schedule, £155.75;

(b) for a person living alone or a householder not falling within subparagraph (a) who is directly responsible for household necessities and rent

(if any), £95.40;

(c) for any other person who is not a householder,  
£83.45;

(d) for a member of a household -

(i) aged 16 years or over, £70.70;

(ii) aged 12 years or over but less than 16  
years, £43.70;

(iii) aged 5 years or over but less than 12  
years, £31.70;

(iv) aged less than 5 years, £23.40.”

**Extent.**

2. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou.

**Citation.**

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 2001.

**Commencement.**

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2002.
