Ordinance of the States **XVI**

1980

Made 31st July, 1980.
Coming Into Operation ... 21st November, 1980.

The Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1980

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the thirty-first day of July, nineteen hundred and eighty, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (2) of section 3 of the Supplementary Benefit (Guernsey) Law, 1971(a), hereby order:—

1. The Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) Ordinance, 1971(b), as amended(c), is hereby further amended as follows, that is to say:—

(a) paragraph 5 of Part II of the First Schedule thereto is hereby repealed and the following paragraph is hereby substituted therefor—

“Normal requirements

5. The requirements of persons shall be as follows, that is to say:—

(a) For a husband and wife or other persons falling within sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 2 of this Schedule—

(i) where the man is
aged sixty-five years
or over £43.20

(ii) in any other case £41.80

(b) For a person living alone or a householder not falling within item (a) of this paragraph who is directly responsible for household necessities and rent (if any)—

(i) where that person
is a man aged sixty-
five years or over
or a woman aged
sixty years or over £27.00

(ii) in any other case £26.30

(c) For any other person—

(i) where that person
is a man aged
sixty-five years or
over or a woman
aged sixty years or
over £22.70

(ii) aged twenty years
or over and who is
not a person to
whom sub-para-
graph (i) of this
item applies £21.75

(iii) aged eighteen years or over but less than twenty years	£14.10
(iv) aged sixteen years or over but less than eighteen years	£11.50
(v) aged thirteen years or over but less than sixteen years	£9.10
(vi) aged eleven years or over but less than thirteen years	£7.45
(vii) aged five years or over but less than eleven years ...	£6.05
(viii) aged less than five years	£4.95”;

(b) in paragraph 13 of Part III of the First Schedule thereto the words “three hundred pounds” are hereby repealed and the words “one thousand pounds” are hereby substituted therefor;

(c) paragraph 14 of the said Part III is hereby repealed and the following paragraph is hereby substituted therefor—

“Calculation of income from capital resources

14. The capital resources taken into account, together with any income derived therefrom shall be treated as equivalent to a weekly income of the following amounts, that is to say:—

(a) so far as the value of the capital resources exceeds one thousand pounds but does not exceed two

thousand pounds, thirteen pence for each complete twenty-five pounds;

- (b) so far as their value exceeds two thousand pounds, twenty-five pence for each complete twenty-five pounds.”;
- (d) in paragraph 15 of the said Part III the words “six pounds” are hereby repealed and the words “ten pounds” are hereby substituted therefor;
- (e) in paragraph 16 of the said Part III, the words “two pounds” are hereby repealed and the words “four pounds” are hereby substituted therefor;
- (f) in paragraph 17 of the said Part III—
- (i) the words “one pound” are hereby repealed and the words “two pounds” are hereby substituted therefor;
 - (ii) the words and brackets “(including any sum taken into account under paragraph 14 of this Schedule)” are hereby repealed;
 - (iii) in sub-paragraph (2) thereof, the words “two pounds” wherever those words occur are hereby repealed and the words “four pounds” are hereby substituted therefor.

Repeals.

2. The Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1977, and sub-paragraph (b) of section one of the Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) Ordinance, 1979, are hereby repealed.

3. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1980. Citation, collective title and commencement.

(2) This Ordinance and the Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) Ordinances, 1971 to 1979 may be cited together as the Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) Ordinances, 1971 to 1980.

(3) This Ordinance shall come into force on the twenty-first day of November, nineteen hundred and eighty.
