**The Supplementary Benefit
(Implementation) (Amendment)
Ordinance, 1982**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-eighth day of July, nineteen hundred and eighty-two, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sub-section (2) of section three of the Supplementary Benefit (Guernsey) Law, 1971(a), hereby order:—

1. The Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) Ordinance, 1971(b), as amended (c), is hereby further amended as follows, that is to say:— Amend-

- (a) sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 3 of Part I of the First Schedule thereto is hereby repealed and the following sub-paragraph is hereby substituted therefor —

“(2) For the purposes of the last preceding sub-paragraph the limit of weekly income shall be £67.50.”;

- (b) paragraph 5 of Part II of the First Schedule thereto is hereby repealed and the following paragraph is hereby substituted therefor—

“Normal requirements

5. The requirements of persons shall be as follows, that is to say:—

- (a) For a husband and wife or other persons falling within sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 2 of this Schedule—

(i) where the man is aged
sixty-five years or
over £52.75

(ii) in any other case £51.00

- (b) For a person living alone or a householder not falling within item (a) of this paragraph who is directly responsible for household necessities and rent (if any) —

(i) where that person is a man
aged sixty-five years or over or
a woman aged sixty years or
over £33.00

(ii) in any other case ... £32.10

- (c) For any other person —
- (i) where that person is a man aged sixty-five years or over or a woman aged sixty years or over £27.70
 - (ii) aged eighteen years or over and who is not a person to whom sub-paragraph (i) of this item applies £26.55
 - (iii) aged sixteen years or over but less than eighteen years £19.60
 - (iv) aged thirteen years or over but less than sixteen years £15.25
 - (v) aged eleven years or over but less than thirteen years £12.00
 - (vi) aged five years or over but less than eleven years £9.25
 - (vii) aged less than five years £7.10.”;

(c) in item (b) of sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 6 of Part II of the First Schedule thereto, the words “one pound and fifty new pence” are hereby repealed and the words “two pounds and fifty pence” are hereby substituted therefor.

2. Sub-paragraph (c) of section 1 of the Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1974^(d), and the Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1981^(e), are hereby repealed. Repeals.

3. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1982.

(2) This Ordinance and the Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) Ordinances, 1971 to 1980, may be cited together as the Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) Ordinances, 1971 to 1982.

(3) This Ordinance shall come into force on the nineteenth day of November, nineteen hundred and eighty-two.
