Ordinance of the States **XVIII**

1984

Made 25th July, 1984.

Coming into Operation ... 16th November, 1984.

The Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1984

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 27th day of June, 1984, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 3(2) of the Supplementary Benefit (Guernsey) Law, 1971(a), hereby order:—

1. The Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) Ordinance, 1971, as amended(b), is hereby further amended as follows:—

(a) sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 3 of Part I of the First Schedule thereto is hereby repealed and the following sub-paragraph is hereby substituted therefor—

“(2) For the purpose of the last preceding sub-paragraph the limit of the weekly income shall be—

- (a) in the case of a woman, other than a widow, to whom section 2(1)(f), (h) and (i) of the Law applies £70;
 - (b) in the case of any other person who is not a person to whom item (a) of this sub-paragraph applies £75.”
- (b) paragraph 5 of Part II of the First Schedule thereto is hereby repealed and the following paragraph is hereby substituted therefor—

“Normal requirements

5. The requirements of persons shall be as follows, that is to say—

- (a) For a husband and wife or other persons falling within paragraph 2(1) of this Schedule—
 - (i) where the man is aged sixty-five years or over £58.70
 - (ii) in any other case ... £56.70
- (b) For a person living alone or a householder not falling within sub-paragraph (a) of this paragraph who is directly responsible for household necessities and rent (if any)—
 - (i) where that person is a man aged sixty-five years or over or a woman aged sixty years or over £36.70

- (ii) where that person is a woman, other than a widow to whom section 2(1)(f), (h) and (i) of the Law applies £35.05
 - (iii) in any other case ... £35.75
- (c) For any other person—
- (i) where that person is a man aged sixty-five years or over or a woman aged sixty years or over £30.80
 - (ii) where that person is a woman, other than a widow, aged eighteen or over to whom section 2(1)(f), (h) and (i) of the Law applies ... £29.00
 - (iii) aged eighteen years or over and who is not a person to whom item (i) or (ii) of this sub-paragraph applies £29.55
 - (iv) where that person is a woman, other than a widow, aged sixteen years or over but less than eighteen years to whom section 2(1)(f), (h) and (i) of the Law applies ... £21.40

- (v) aged sixteen years or over but less than eighteen years and who is not a person to whom item (iv) of this sub-paragraph applies £21.85
- (vi) where that person is a woman over school leaving age but less than sixteen years and is a person to whom section 2(1)(h) and (i) of the Law applies ... £16.65
- (vii) aged thirteen years or over but less than sixteen years and is not a woman to whom item (vi) of this sub-paragraph applies £16.95
- (viii) aged eleven years or over but less than thirteen years £13.40
- (ix) aged five years or over but less than eleven years £10.25
- (x) aged less than five years £7.90"

Repeal. 2. The Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1983(c), is hereby repealed.

Extent. 3. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1984. Citation.

5. This Ordinance and the Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) Ordinances, 1971 to 1983, may be cited together as the Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) Ordinances, 1971 to 1984. Collective title.

6. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 16th day of November, 1984. Commencement.
