**1987**

Coming into Operation ... 13th November, 1987.

**The Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1987**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 24th day of June, 1987, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 3(2) of the Supplementary Benefit (Guernsey) Law, 1971(a), hereby order:—

1. The Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) Ordinance, 1971, as amended(b), is hereby further amended as follows:— Amendment of Ordinance of 1971.

- (a) paragraph 3(2) of Part I of the First Schedule thereto is hereby repealed and the following sub-paragraph is hereby substituted therefor—

“(2) For the purpose of the last preceding sub-paragraph the limit of the weekly income shall be £100.”;

- (b) paragraph 5 of Part II of the First Schedule thereto is hereby repealed and the following paragraph is hereby substituted therefor—

“*Normal requirements*

5. The requirements of persons shall be as follows, that is to say—

- (a) For a husband and wife or other persons falling within paragraph 2(1) of this Schedule—

(i) where the man is aged sixty-five years or over £80.00

(ii) in any other case ... £77.00

- (b) For a person living alone or a householder not falling within sub-paragraph (a) of this paragraph who is directly responsible for household necessities and rent (if any)—

(i) where that person is a man aged sixty-five years or over or a woman aged sixty years or over ... £50.00

(ii) in any other case ... £48.00

(c) For any other person—

- (i) where that person is a man aged sixty-five years or over or a woman aged sixty years or over ... .. £42.00
- (ii) aged eighteen years or over, and who is not a person to whom item (i) of this sub-paragraph applies ... .. £40.00
- (iii) aged sixteen years or over but less than eighteen years ... .. £28.00
- (iv) aged thirteen years or over but less than sixteen years ... .. £22.00
- (v) aged eleven years or over but less than thirteen years ... .. £17.00
- (vi) aged five years or over but less than eleven years ... .. £13.00
- (vii) aged less than five years ... .. £10.00”;

(c) in paragraph 6(1)(b) of Part II of the First Schedule thereto the words “two pounds and fifty pence” are hereby repealed and the words “ten pounds” are hereby substituted therefor;

(d) in Part III of the First Schedule thereto—

- (i) in paragraph 14 thereof the words “two thousand” wherever they occur are

hereby repealed and the words “five thousand” are hereby substituted therefor;

- (ii) in paragraph 16 thereof the words “four pounds” are hereby repealed and the words “five pounds” are hereby substituted therefor;
- (iii) in paragraph 17(1) thereof the words “two pounds” are hereby repealed and the words “two pounds and fifty pence” are hereby substituted therefor;
- (iv) in paragraph 17(2) thereof the words “four pounds” wherever they occur are hereby repealed and the words “five pounds” are hereby substituted therefor.

**Repeals.** 2. Paragraph (e) and sub-paragraph (i) and (iii) of paragraph (f) of section I of the Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1980(c), the Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1982(d), and the Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1986(e), are hereby repealed.

**Extent.** 3. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou.

**Citation.** 4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1987.

5. This Ordinance and the Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) Ordinances, 1971 to 1985, may be cited together as the Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) Ordinances, 1971 to 1987. Collective title.

6. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 13th day of November, 1987. Commencement.
