**The Supplementary Benefit (Implementation)  
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1992**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 30th day of July, 1992<sup>(a)</sup>, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 3(2) of the Supplementary Benefit (Guernsey) Law, 1971<sup>(b)</sup>, hereby order:-

**Amendment of Ordinance**

1. In the Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) Ordinance, 1971, as amended<sup>(c)</sup>:-

- (a) for paragraph 3 (2) of the First Schedule substitute -  
"(2) For the purposes of sub-paragraph (1) the limit of the weekly income -  
(a) of a person whose requirements are in accordance with paragraphs 5 and 8 of this Schedule shall be £149.50;  
(b) of a person who is residing in a residential home and whose requirements are in accordance with paragraph 7 of this Schedule shall be £252;

(c) of a person who is residing in a hospital or a nursing home as a patient and whose requirements are in accordance with paragraph 7 of this Schedule shall be £289.";

(b) for paragraph 5 of the First Schedule substitute -

**"Normal requirements**

5.(1) The requirements of persons who are continuously in need of a supplementary benefit for a period not exceeding 6 months shall be as follows -

| (ii) aged 16 years or over but less than 18 years   | £39.75  |
| (iii) aged 13 years or over but less than 16 years  | £30.25  |
| (iv) aged 11 years or over but less than 13 years   | £23.00  |
| (v) aged 5 years or over but less than 11 years   | £21.00  |
| (vi) aged less than 5 years   | £15.75. |

(2) The requirements of persons to whom a supplementary benefit has been payable for a continuous period of 6 months shall be as follows -

| (a) for a husband and wife or other persons falling within paragraph 2(1) of this Schedule  | £116.00 |
| (b) for a person living alone or a householder not falling within paragraph (a) who is directly responsible for household necessities and rent (if any) | £71.00  |
| (c) for any other person -  |         |
| (i) aged 18 years or over   | £61.75  |
| (ii) aged 16 years or over but less than 18 years   | £44.00  |

(iii) aged 13 years or over but less than 16 years	£32.50
(iv) aged 11 years or over but less than 13 years	£25.00
(v) aged 5 years or over but less than 11 years	£22.00
(vi) aged less than 5 years	£17.75.

(3) For the purposes of reckoning any continuous period of 6 months for the purposes of sub-paragraph (2), any period in the aggregate not exceeding 28 days, during which a supplementary benefit has not been payable, shall be disregarded."

**Repeals**

2. The Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1991<sup>(d)</sup> is repealed.

**Extent**

3. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou.

**Citation**

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1992.

**Commencement**

5. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 6th day of November, 1992.
