**The Television Duty (Guernsey)
Ordinance, 1958.**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the first day of October, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (1) of section two, section three and subsection (2) of section five of the Television Duty (Guernsey) Law, 1958, and of all other powers thereunto them enabling, hereby order:—

1. The Television Duty (Guernsey) Law, 1958, shall come into force on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and fifty-nine.
2. The standard yearly rate of television duty chargeable in pursuance of subsection (1) of section two of the Television Duty (Guernsey) Law, 1958, shall be one pound.
3. Television duty shall be paid to the Postmaster General for the account of the States of Guernsey at

any post office at which television licences are issued in the Island of Guernsey or in the Island of Alderney, as the case may be.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Television Duty (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1958.
