Ordinance of the States. **XL**
1950

Made 13th December, 1950
Coming into Operation 1st January, 1951

**The Traffic (Approval of Regulations)
(Miscellaneous) Ordinance, 1950.**

THE STATES, on the representations of the Island Police Committee, have approved the regulations set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance, which regulations have been made by the said Committee under and by virtue of the provisions of Article X (as amended) of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of the 2nd day of March, 1929, and direct that the same shall come into force on the 1st day of January, 1951.

SCHEDULE.

Regulation K 7A :

(1) No vehicle shall be driven or ridden at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the main road from Les De'isles Chapel, via the King's Mills, to the junction of La Hurette Road with the King's Mills Road in the Parish of the Castel.

(2) Regulation K 7, approved by Ordinance XVII of the 2nd day of April, 1938, is hereby revoked.

Regulation J 2A :

Regulation J 2, approved by Ordinance VII of the 9th day of June, 1945, is hereby amended by the revocation therein of the words “ (from a special limit sign opposite house known as “ Lower Bertozerie ”) ” and by the substitution therein of the word “ vehicle ” for the word “ vehicule ”.

Regulation L 2A :

Regulation L 2, approved by Ordinance II of the 21st day of January, 1929, is hereby revoked.

Regulation I (XXIII) :

Save with the permission of the Chief Officer of Police, no vehicle shall be driven or ridden along that portion of Les Canichers which lies between Saint Julian's Avenue and Bosq Lane in the Parish of Saint Peter Port.

For the purposes of this Regulation, the expression “ vehicle ” shall have the same meaning as it bears in relation to Regulation I (XXII).

Regulation I (XXIV) :

Save with the permission of the Chief Officer of Police no vehicle shall be driven or ridden along the southern of the two roads leading from l'Eree Road towards the Car Park opposite to Lihou Island otherwise than from east to west or along the northern of the said two roads otherwise than from west to east.

For the purposes of this Regulation, the expression “ vehicle ” shall have the same meaning as it bears in relation to Regulation I (XXII).
