## Ordinance of the States **XI** 1990

Made ... .. 25th April, 1990.  
Coming into Operation ... 1st May, 1990.

### **The Traffic Offences (Fixed Penalties) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1990**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 28th March 1990<sup>(a)</sup>, hereby order:—

1. In the Traffic Offences (Fixed Penalties) Ordinance, 1989<sup>(b)</sup>— Amendments to Ordinance of 1989.

- (a) for paragraph (c) of section 5(1) substitute:
- “(c) the payment is accompanied by:
- (i) the fixed penalty notice to which it relates; or
  - (ii) a notice to owner served in respect of that fixed penalty notice; or
  - (iii) a letter to the States Treasurer signed under the authority of the Chief Officer setting out the number of the fixed penalty notice and date of the offence concerned.”;

- (b) in section 5(3), for “tendering payment of” substitute “paying”, and for “he shall return the amount tendered, as soon as possible, to that person” substitute “he shall, as soon as reasonably practicable, repay the amount paid to him in respect of that fixed penalty”;
- (c) for paragraph (a) of section 5(4) substitute:  
 “(a) the States Treasurer shall, as soon as reasonably practicable:  
 (i) inform the Chief Officer of the payment; and  
 (ii) if the person making the payment requests a receipt and either makes it in person or gives a name and address to which the receipt may be sent, provide a receipt bearing the number of the fixed penalty notice concerned; and”;
- (d) section 8(1) is renumbered as section 8, and in that section for “by registered post or by recorded delivery service”, wherever appearing, substitute “by post”;
- (e) in section 10, for “1988” substitute “1989”;
- (f) at the end of Schedule 1 insert the following entries in columns (1), (2) and (3) respectively

(g) in the address at the end of Schedule 2 delete "The Quay".

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Traffic Offences (Fixed Penalties) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1990. Citation.

3. This Ordinance and the Traffic Offences (Fixed Penalties) Ordinance, 1989 may be cited together as the Traffic Offences (Fixed Penalties) Ordinances, 1989 and 1990. Collective title.

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 1st May 1990. Commencement,
