**The Traffic Temporary Regulations
Ordinance, 1950.**

THE STATES, on the representations of the Island Police Committee, hereby order as follows :—

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (2) of Article ten of the Ordinance entitled " Ordonnance provisoire relative au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile " (No. X of 1929) (hereinafter referred to as " the principal Ordinance "), any regulation made by the Island Police Committee (hereinafter referred to as " the Committee ")—

- (i) as to the proper regulation of traffic in a particular locality ;
- (ii) as to the maximum speed of or route to be followed by any or every class of vehicle in a particular locality ;
- (iii) as to the class of vehicles permitted to use a parking place ;
- (iv) as to the maximum period during which a vehicle is permitted to remain in a parking place ;
- (v) as to the conditions upon or the manner in which a vehicle shall be placed and permitted to be left in a parking place .

and expressed by the Committee to be made only either in order to ascertain the best method of regulating vehicular traffic in this Island or in order to provide for temporary circumstances shall have effect, subject to the provisions of this Ordinance, as if the said regulation had been approved and embodied in an Ordinance by the States in accordance with the provisions of the said paragraph and shall be deemed to have been properly made under the said paragraph.

2. No regulation having effect under the provisions of this Ordinance shall be valid for a period of more than two months (hereinafter referred to as "the operative period") commencing with the date of the making thereof by the Committee :

PROVIDED that nothing in this section contained shall prejudice or prevent the institution or prosecution of proceedings after the expiration of the operative period in respect of the contravention of any such regulation during such period.

3. (1) The provisions of any regulation having effect under the provisions of this Ordinance shall be published by the Committee on at least two occasions in La Gazette Officielle prior to the date of the coming into effect thereof.

(2) In the issue of La Gazette Officielle immediately prior to the date of the expiration of the operative period the Committee shall publish a notice stating the date on which the regulation will cease to have effect :

PROVIDED that the provisions of this subsection shall not apply in the case of any such regulation which is approved and embodied without substantial modification in an Ordinance before the expiration of the operative period.

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 11th day of January, ~~1949~~ 1950.
