The Transfer of Functions Ordinance, 1991

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of 14th March, 1991(a), and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 7 of the Health and Safety at Work etc. (Guernsey) Law, 1979(b) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

Board of Trade and Industry.

1. The functions of the States Board of Trade and Industry and of its President under the enactments specified in Schedule 1 are transferred respectively to the States Board of Employment, Industry and Commerce and to its President.

Labour and Welfare Committee.

2. The functions of the States Labour and Welfare Committee under the enactments specified in Schedule 2 are transferred to the States Board of Employment, Industry and Commerce.

Savings and transitional.

3. Anything done before the date of commencement of this Ordinance or in the process of being done on that date by or in relation to -

- (a) the States Board of Trade and Industry or its President under any enactment specified in Schedule 1; or
- (b) the States Labour and Welfare Committee under any enactment specified in Schedule 2,

shall have effect as if done or (as the case may be) may be continued by or in relation to the States Board of Employment, Industry and Commerce or (as the case may be) its President.

Amendments.

4. The enactments specified in Schedule 3 are amended as therein mentioned.

Citation.

5. This Ordinance may be cited as the Transfer of Functions Ordinance, 1991.
