The following report from the Committee of Council for the Affairs of Jersey and Guernsey was today read at the Board:

"In accordance with Your Majesty's General Order of Reference of 22 February 1952 the Committee have considered a Petition of the States of Guernsey:

"That, in pursuance of their Resolution of 27th April 2006, the States of Deliberation at a meeting on 26th July 2006 approved a *Projet de Loi* entitled *The Vehicular Traffic (Causing Death by Driving) (Guernsey) (Amendment) Law 2006* and requested the Bailiff to present a most humble Petition to Your Majesty in Council praying for Your Royal Sanction to it. That the *Projet de Loi* is as set forth in the attached Schedule. The Petition most humbly prays that Your Majesty might be graciously pleased to sanction *The Vehicular Traffic (Causing Death by Driving) (Guernsey) (Amendment) Law 2006*, and to order that it shall have force of law in the Island of Guernsey.

"The Committee have considered the *Projet de Loi* and have agreed to report that it may be advisable for Your Majesty to approve and ratify it".

Her Majesty, having taken the report into consideration, was pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to approve and ratify the *Projet de Loi* (a copy of which is annexed to this Order) and to order that it, together with this Order, shall have the force of law in the Island of Guernsey and shall be entered on the Register of the Island of Guernsey and observed accordingly.

Her Majesty's Officers in the Bailiwick of Guernsey, and all others whom it may concern, are therefore to take notice of Her Majesty's Order and to proceed accordingly.

PROJET DE LOI

ENTITLED

The Vehicular Traffic (Causing Death by Driving) (Guernsey) (Amendment) Law, 2006

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 27th April 2006^a, have approved the following provisions which, subject to the Sanction of Her Most Excellent Majesty in Council, shall have force of law in the Island of Guernsey.

Amendment to Law of 1957.

1. In section 1(1) of the Vehicular Traffic (Causing Death by Driving) Law, 1957^b for the word "five" substitute "14".

Citation.

2. This Law may be cited as the Vehicular Traffic (Causing Death by Driving) (Guernsey) (Amendment) Law, 2006.
