Made 30th January, 1969.
Coming into Operation 1st February, 1969.

**The Vehicular Traffic (Driving Test Fee)
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1969**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the eighteenth day of December, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight, hereby order:—

1. In paragraph (4) of Article VIII of the Ordinance entitled “Ordonnance relative au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile” of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, as amended^(a), the words “The applicant shall, prior to taking such test, pay to the Committee for the account of the States a fee of fifteen shillings which sum shall not be returnable.” are hereby repealed and the words “The applicant shall, prior to taking such test, pay to the Committee for the account of the States a fee of twenty-five shillings which sum shall not be returnable.” are hereby substituted therefor.
